Warren Wiersbe tells that when Christopher Columbus made his voyage west in 1492, he kept two log books, one of which contained falsified information. He wanted his men to believe that they were closer to land than they really were. Apparently Columbus felt that the morale of the crew was more important than the integrity of the captain (Warren W. Wiersbe, *The Bible Exposition Commentary*.)

Unlike Columbus, our Leader, Jesus, has told us what the Christian life really involves. On his way to Jerusalem, Jesus said to all those around him, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me" (Luke 9:23).

Unfortunately, many so-called pastors and preachers of our day offer a fictional Jesus who makes no demands on his followers and promises them lives of uninterrupted "health, wealth, and happiness." Yet, Jesus has made it clear, "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world" (John 16:33).

As we look ahead to Palm Sunday we would do well to make sure that we are following the Jesus of the Bible. He has told us what to expect in the world, how we should respond, and has promised us victory through His cross.




IMPORTANT: Please check for expired dates on all food. They cannot accept expired items.
