Join us Friday, June 24 from 6-7:30pm for a free Kickoff cookout with food, games and pre-registration for VBS.

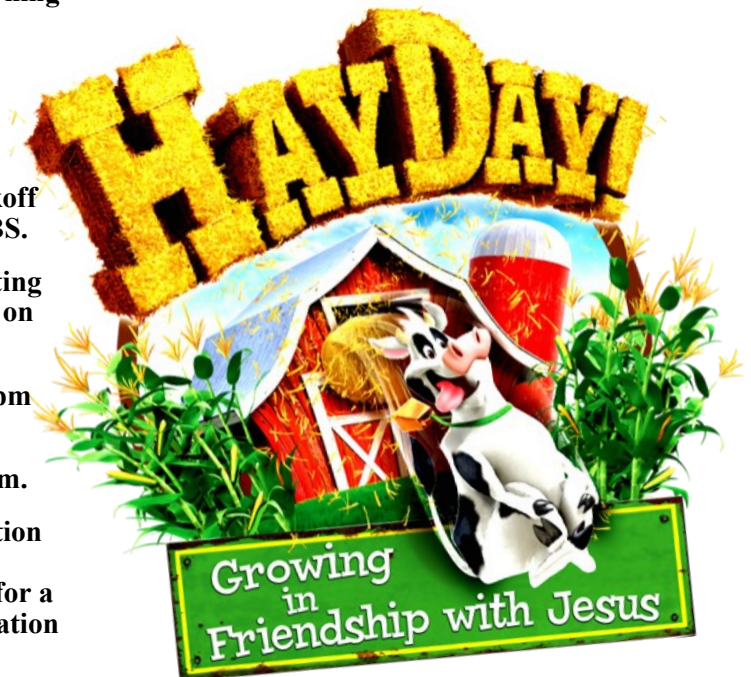
Children will participate in team-building games, exciting Bible songs, outreach projects, and learn Bible truths on Saturday & Sunday.
